After all what are we without a hint of imagination, some stories in the eyes and wonders in heart.

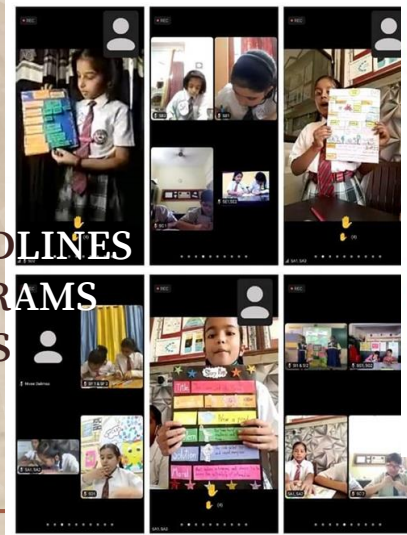
